Quick Reference Guide

Certification of Documents



TRUSTED REFEREES

In New Zealand documents may be certified by a 'Trusted Referee'. A Trusted Referee is a person who holds one of the following positions:

- Commonwealth representative (as defined in the Oaths and Declarations Act 1957).
- Member of the police.
- Justice of the Peace.
- Registered Medical Doctor.
- Kaumatua (as verified through a reputable source).
- Registered teacher.
- Minister of religion.
- Lawyer (as defined in the Lawyers and Conveyancers Act 2006).
- Notary public.
- New Zealand Honorary consul.
- Member of Parliament.

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- Chartered Accountant (within the meaning of section 19 of the New Zealand Institute of Chartered Accountants Act 1996).
 - A person who has the legal authority to take statutory declarations or the equivalent in New Zealand.

Overseas

When certification occurs overseas, documents may be certified by a person authorised by law in that country to take statutory declarations or the equivalent in that country.



ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

In addition to holding one of the positions above, for a person to be eligible to be a Trusted Referee, he or she must also satisfy the following criteria:

- Be at least 16 years old.
- Not be related to the person presenting the documents for certification.
- Not live at the same address as the person presenting the documents for certification.
- Not be the spouse or partner of the person presenting the documents for certification.
- Not be involved in the transaction or business that the certification relates to.



SIGN OFF

The Trusted Referee must also include the following information on each document being certified:

- Name.
- Signature.
- Occupation.
- Date of certification (which must be within 3 months of receiving the document).
- Preferred contact details (in case we need to contact you).

HOW MUST DOCUMENTS BE CERTIFIED

A Trusted Referee must sight the original document, make a photocopy of the document and then make a statement to the following effect on the photocopied document (as applicable):

Photographic Document

"I certify that this is a true copy of the original, which I have sighted, and the photo represents a true likeness of the person presenting the document to me for certification."

Non-Photographic Document

"I certify that this is a true copy of the original, which I have sighted."



ACCEPTABLE DOCUMENTS

identity Documents

Document(s) from either option 1 or option 2:

Option 1

Passport (NZ or overseas); **OR** NZ Firearms Licence.

Option 2

NZ Drivers Licence*.

and

New Zealand Birth Certificate.

New Zealand Citizenship Certificate.

18+ Card (Kiwi Access Card)

Bank Card from a NZ registered bank*; OR

NZ Bank Statement; OR

Document or statement issued by a Government Agency within the past 12 months; **OR** SuperGold Card.

Proof of Address

One of the following, dated within the last 12 months, containing your FULL name:

Utility Bill / Rates Invoice.

Statement issued by a Government Agency.

Bank Statement.

Letter issued by a Registered Retirement Village.



CHECK

Has the document been certified by a Trusted

Referee?

- ✓ Is the Trusted Referee eligible to make the certification?
- Does the certification include the appropriate wording, name, occupation, the signature of the Trusted Referee and the date of the certification?
- Are the documents "acceptable"?
 - Use the 'Certification Form for Trusted Referees'
- TIP to make certification easy.

^{*}If you are sending a photocopy of a Drivers Licence or a Bank Card, BOTH SIDES of the card must be copied and certified.
